Project Report

The final report should include components/headings indicated below.

1. Title Page

• title of your project, your name and name of client(s), including department/institutional affiliation, and academic term

2. Introduction

- statement of the wider research question
- specific research questions/hypotheses to be addressed in this report

3. Methods

- description of sampling design
- data (sample size, variables)
- statistical tools used (cite references)
- software (version) and significance level used

4. Results

- data description
 - use effective graphs, tables to communicate results, (pay attention to titles, labels, and include units)
 - number tables and figures consecutively, use a separate sequence of numbers for tables and figures
 - comment on figures and tables
- inferential statistics
 - important: use APA style for presenting results
 - might need subsections for each research question/hypothesis

5. Discussion

- give answers to research questions in plain language
- discuss logical reasons for results either supporting or not supporting hypotheses
- point out possible limitations of the study
- discuss sources of error
- potentially suggest improvements in methodology
